Dear Church

“And we all, who with unveiled faces contemplate the Lord’s glory, are being transformed into His image with ever-increasing glory, which comes from the Lord, who is the Spirit.” 2 Cor. 3:18

How is our transformation into the image of Jesus coming along? Do we when we look in the mirror see Jesus looking back? Well this scripture says that as we contemplate His glory, our transformation is taking place - when our minds are set on Jesus.

In Acts 4 when Peter and John stood before the Sanhedrin ‘they were astonished because they perceived that they were uneducated, common men.’ But they also recognized that they had been with Jesus. There was something in their boldness - perhaps it was the wisdom of their words, maybe their eloquence, or their understanding of Scripture - that didn’t fit in with their designated social status in that society. Have we reached the point where it’s obvious that we have faith in the only Truth available in this world? Do we rise above the crowd, or do we blend in so well with the world that no one notices anything different about us. not cause anyone to take note, if we do we need to start to contemplate His glory.

If we’ve blended in comfortably, perhaps it’s time to start really contemplating His glory?
