1 Corinthians 4:1

'Let a man so consider us, as servants of Christ and stewards of the mysteries of God'

Paul in this verse to the Corinthian church call himself a 'servant of Christ' and a 'steward', in other translations he call himself a 'minister'. This come from the Greek word 'huperetas'. This word doesn't only refer to the position of minister but also to an attitude. It refers to an attitude that is essential to get the job done, an attitude that would apply to achieving success in all walks of life.

Interestingly in classical Greek society this word was used to describe lower class criminals.

The criminals who were so low, so frowned upon that they were removed from society and imprisoned on great ship and made to row continuously, this was a life time sentence, there was to be no reprieve, no probation, that was their life rowing the ships until they reached their destination. They had to row at the pace the drum beat on the ship required.

I have realised in the Christian walk there are no instant success stories, it takes a lot of commitment. dedication, effort to realise the dream that God has put in our hearts. It can take a lifetimes work to get to our own promised land and it is on that journey that God will deal with our faults.

Paul was a great achiever, he changed the world for the Gospel more than any other man except for Jesus and he recognised that it takes a lot of effort, pain and persistence to get the Lord's work done



In this world of instant gratification, it is alien to us to have to apply ourselves like this we want satisfaction straight away, we want microwave meals, junk food, instant pleasure, we want to push the happiness button and be filled with joy, but slave ships. > So I want to encourage you to keep pace with the drum beat of the pace that the Holy Spirit is setting for us.
